History of the Green and Gold

Although the college was founded in 1867, the school went several years without establishing school colors. Following an increase in the college's participation in athletics beginning in 1889, the colors red and black were adopted. However these colors were used only briefly. In 1892 a committee was established to re-evaluate the school's need for colors. In 1893 the committee finally voted that green and gold would become the permanent colors representing McDaniel.

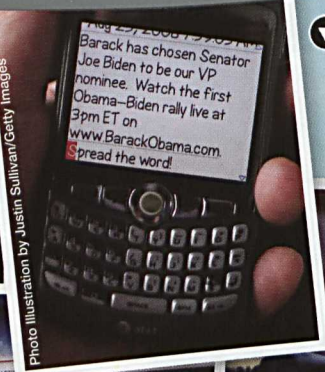

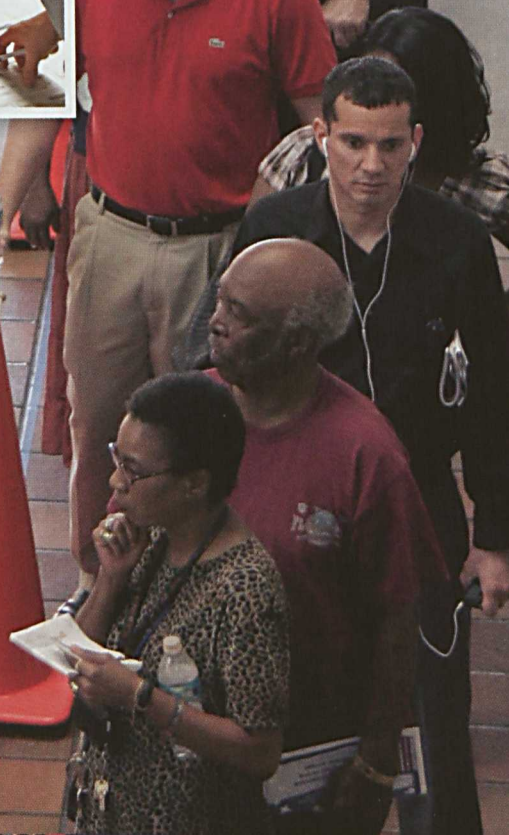

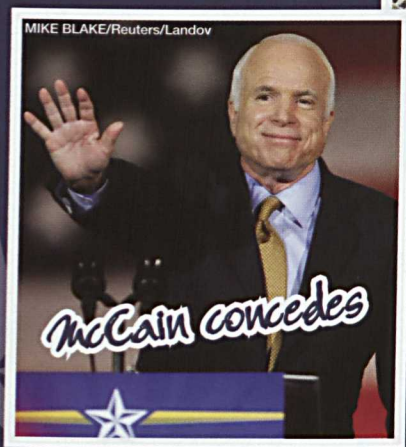

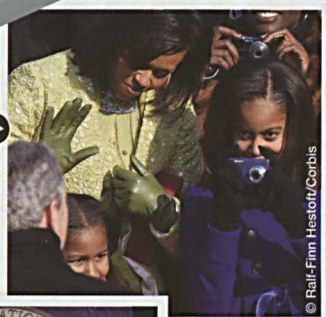

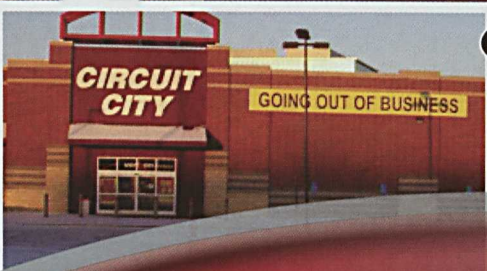

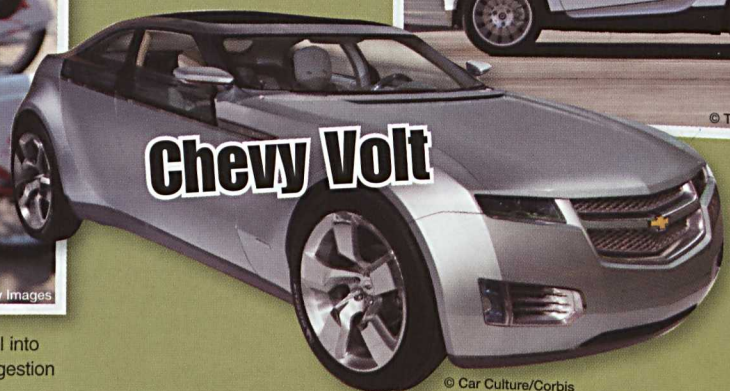

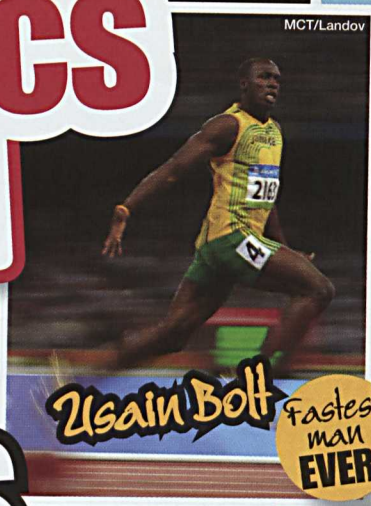

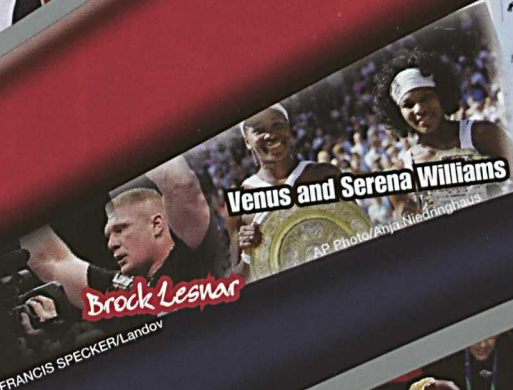

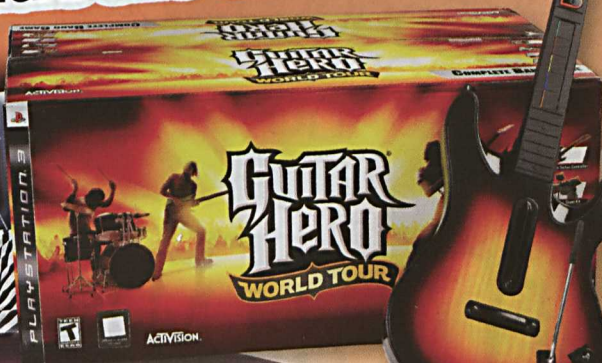
